Here is a rough outline of each day: (Note: Breakfast, lunch, and dinner will be served at the CRU)

Days generally begin around 8-9am. Days 1-3 generally end around 5pm (nurse may come in later for occasional blood draw on Days 2 and 3). Understand that the testing and order of testing may change.

- Bicycle Stress Test

- 2 Blood Draws

Day 3:

- Fasting Blood Draw/Vitals/EKG
- Tender Point testing/Dolorimetry
- Cognitive Testing
- Bicycle Stress Test
- Cognitive Testing
- fMRI
- Blood Draw
- Conclude Study: Speak with Dr. Baraniuk
- Discharge
